### REGISTRATION

No later than Saturday, 30 May, by using the special Excel entry form at the [meeting website](#). One club, one form.

### ENTRY FEE

90 DKR/event in the age group 8-15 years (YOB 2010+) – 120 DKR/event from 16 years and older (YOB -2009). All entries must be paid upon arrival in Danish currency with credit card when picking up bib-numbers.

### LATE ENTRY

Not guaranteed and subject to paying double entry fee.

### TRANSPORTATION

The venue is close to the Copenhagen Airport and the Copenhagen Central Station.

### ACCOMODATION

There will be several possibilities for hostels, campsites and hotels – see more details on the [meeting website](#).

### FOOD & BEVERAGE

## Tail wind at 100 og 200m

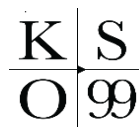
If there continuously is a head wind at 100 and 200m, then we will move the
